How to Get Around and Park Downtown during Construction on University Ave., Broom St., Gilman St., and the Capitol Square

There will be several road construction projects in downtown Madison spring-summer 2010. Access to all businesses and parking ramps and lots will be maintained at all times during the projects. Alternate routes are recommended for some projects. **See other side for MAP** of closures, alternate routes and parking:

- **Broom St. between Doty & Johnson:** NOW OPEN. Construction completed.
- **University Ave. between Park & East Campus Mall,** NOW OPEN. Construction completed
- **Park Street from Observatory to Johnson:** One-way southbound May 17 – early Sep.
- **Park Street from Johnson to University:** Closed & detoured, May 17 – early Sep. Alternate routes:
 - For westbound University Ave. traffic wanting to go south on Park St.: turn left on Brooks, left on Johnson, and then right on Park.
 - Southbound Park St. traffic (from Langdon): Turn right on University, left on Brooks, left on Johnson, and then right on Park.
 - For northbound Park St. traffic: Turn left on Dayton, right on Mills, and then left on University Ave. (Note: You will still be able to get to Johnson from Park.) The detour will be listed as: "West University Avenue.")
- **Langdon St. from Lake St. to Park St.:** One-way westbound. May 17 – early Sep.
- **Observatory Drive:** Portions closed and/or one-way, May 17 - early Sep.
- **200 Block West Gilman St. (from State St. to Henry St.),** June 8 – late August, under construction, local traffic and business access only. Use Gorham St. to get to public parking in the Buckeye Lot.
- **100 block N. Pinckney closed at N. Hamilton St.,** NOW OPEN. Construction completed.
